

^aWould need to be a less than 7 week clerkship, preferably a 4 to 5 week block.

^bClinical continuity experience refers to 1 to 1.5 days per week of a longitudinal clinical experience. Each experience could be 3 to 4 months in duration. The objective is to maintain and improve clinical skills during the time the student is primarily learning and conducting research. It would be optimal if medical school credit could also be awarded for this.

^cCould also be done in the third year, depending upon how many Core Clerkships are felt to be necessary prior to taking the intersession. If Intersession III is taken in the 4th year, then some allowance would need to be made for attendance in the 6th Core Clerkship.
